Please read the following information and review the camp policies & what to wear with your child.

CHECK-IN / CHECK-DUT:

Check-In on the first day of camp is from 3PM to 4PM @ The Hampton Inn (155 Interchange Blvd. Ormond Beach FL 32174).

- **Leaders** must arrive for Check-In no later than 3pm. (This includes all room leaders. You must be present before the students begin to arrive.)
- **Students** must arrive for Check-In between 3pm and 4pm. Check-Out time on the last day of camp is 3:30pm from Calvary Christian Center.

CAMP AGE:

Summer Encounter is for students entering grades 6 thru 12. Any Young Adult, ages 18 thru 30, wishing to attend Summer Encounter <u>MUST</u> have had a background check, filled out a Calvary Youth Leadership Application and also <u>MUST</u> serve as a room leader.

CAMP REGISTRATION FEES:

The price of camp includes: registration, lodging, meals and secondary insurance. We strongly recommend you register as soon as possible as there is limited space at our facility. The only way to guarantee your space is to register.

REFUNDS:

Due to programming costs and up front budget expenses Summer Encounter will not be able to offer refunds for students under any circumstances.

LICE POLICY:

Due to very close living conditions, major disruptions occur when there is a health problem. Lice are nearly impossible to treat in close living conditions such as camp. If a student is found to have lice, we will have to ask that they be picked up from camp, treated, and be nit free for 24-hours before returning to camp. It is recommended that these situations be monitored before leaving for camp. Summer Encounter will have complete checks before registration takes place. Please help us avoid embarrassing situations of having to either not admit or send a camper home.

MEDICATION / SPECIAL MEDICAL REQUESTS:

Please be sure to fully complete the *Summer Encounter Camper Medication Form* on which you must list all medications your child will be bringing and any special needs the First Aid Director should be made aware of. *This form is to be placed in a Ziploc bag with the medications and submitted to the First Aid Director on the first day of camp.*

ROOMS:

All students will be assigned to a room with accompanying chaperone before arriving on the campgrounds. Under no circumstances will any student be allowed to change rooms at any point. We do not spend time in the rooms during camp other than to sleep, so we expect full cooperation when it comes to rooming arrangements.

NON-CAMPER POLICY:

Summer Encounter is a **CLOSED** camp. All camp activities including evening services are open <u>ONLY</u> to registered campers and staff. Any child, student or adult violating this policy will be asked to leave the grounds by Summer Encounter staff.

LOST & FOUND:

Summer Encounter is not responsible for any lost/stolen items. It will be the student's responsibility to keep up with their things.

CAMP PROPERTY DAMAGE:

Charges for items broken/damaged during camp will be billed to all parties/individuals involved.

CAMP POLICIES:

By registering for camp, you agree to abide by all rules set forth by Summer Encounter. Policies are given as guidelines for every camper to follow. This code of conduct has been established for your student's protection and the benefit of every person present. The lack of cooperation, unnecessary roughness, lack of respect for property, or an unwholesome attitude on the part of any camper will result in expulsion from camp and will not be able to return. The expense of transporting the expelled camper(s) home from camp is the responsibility of the parents/guardians.

- We should strive at all times to conduct ourselves as Christian ladies and gentlemen with proper consideration shown for others.
- Attendance at all scheduled activities is mandatory.
- Rooms and grounds must be kept clean. Take care of property.
 Campers are responsible to pay for any damage to rooms and hotel property. Should an offender not be found, the hotel room members will be charged equally.
- Campers must be in bed and quiet at "lights out."
- Campers are not to enter another room of the opposite sex.
- Due to security issues, we have a closed camp.

- No camper shall be allowed to leave the grounds or go out of bounds without proper permission from a camp executive.
- No fireworks, firearms, tobacco, alcohol, drugs, airsoft or paintball guns, improper reading materials, or pets will be allowed on the grounds.
- No excessive practical joking. Hazing and destruction of property will result in dismissal from camp.
- There is ZERO tolerance for bullying. Immediate dismissal of students bullying other students.

WHAT TO BRING:

- Bible, Notepad & Pen
- Recreational Clothes
- Gym shoes
- Soap, Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Shampoo, Hairdryer
- Modest Swimwear for hotel pool
- Sunscreen & Bug Spray
- Dirty Clothes Bag
- Extra Money for food, snacks, and MERCH!

Please clearly label all items. Campers are responsible for personal belongings. Again Summer Encounter is **NOT** responsible if any items are lost/stolen.

WHAT **NOT** TO BRING:

No electronic devices, laptops, video games, silly string, water guns, water balloons, tape, or spray paint products. Please be respectful to remove, move, or turn off any cellular devices if asked by any Leadership.

WHAT TO WEAR:

- Abbreviated Attire such as half shirts, backless or halter-type dresses or shirts, spaghetti straps or extremely tight garments will not be allowed by campers or staff.
- Shoes must be worn at all times including to and from the pool.
- Shorts of modest length may be worn
- Dark colored t-shirts must be worn by BOTH guys and girls over bathing suits to, from and while in the pool. T-shirts must cover chest and stomach. No thong swimsuits allowed!
- Recreation during the day is often messy. Keep this in mind when you are planning what clothes to bring. You will want to bring older clothes and shoes that you can get wet, muddy and generally dirty. Ladies must wear dark colored t-shirts for recreation.
- If a camper's clothing is deemed inappropriate they will be asked to change.
