I further understand that the doctors, dentists, and other providers attending to my child will take all reasonable safety precautions during their care. Further, as parent or legal guardian I am responsible for the health care decisions for my minor child and agree that my insurance plan is the primary plan to pay for the dental, medical, or hospital care or treatment that is given to my child. Any policy of the church or organization sponsoring this event will be used as the secondary coverage.
