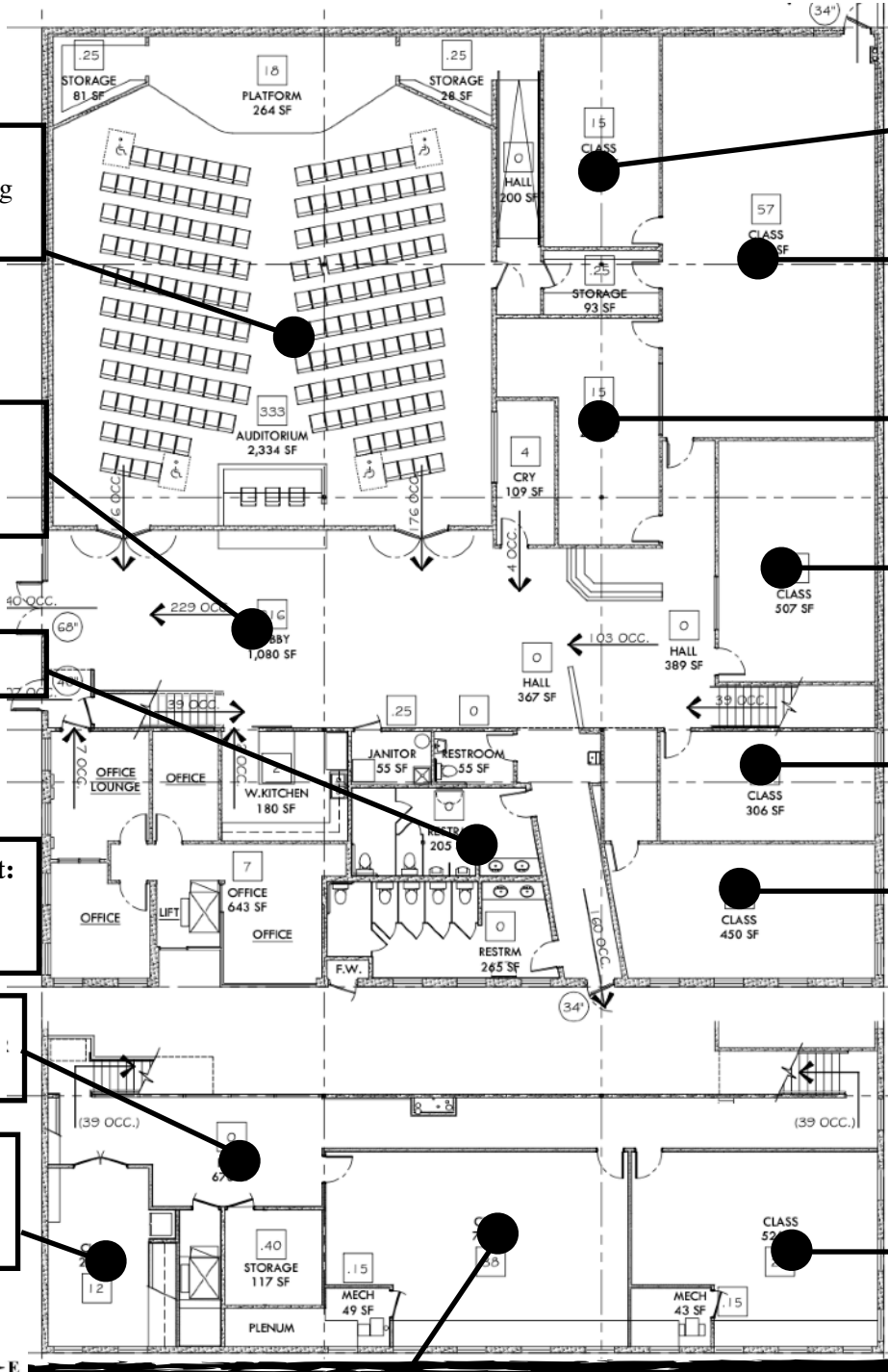
The Architect has designed an amazing building. Can the Builders and Contractors come together to build the masterpiece?

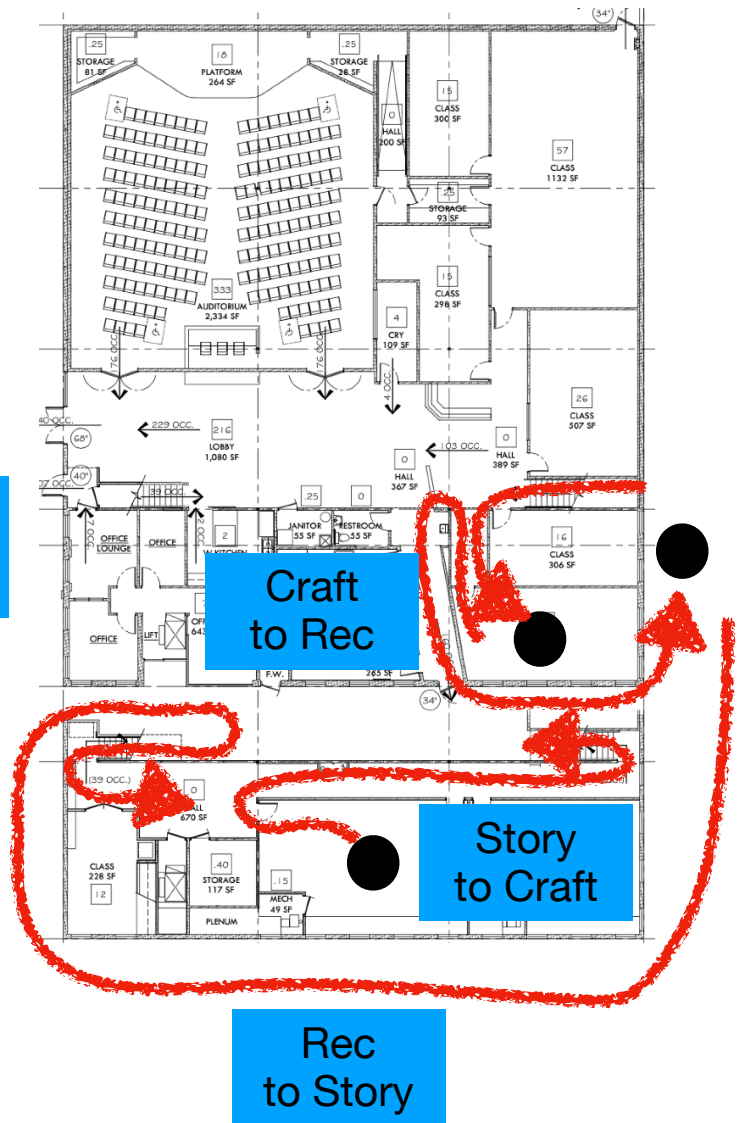
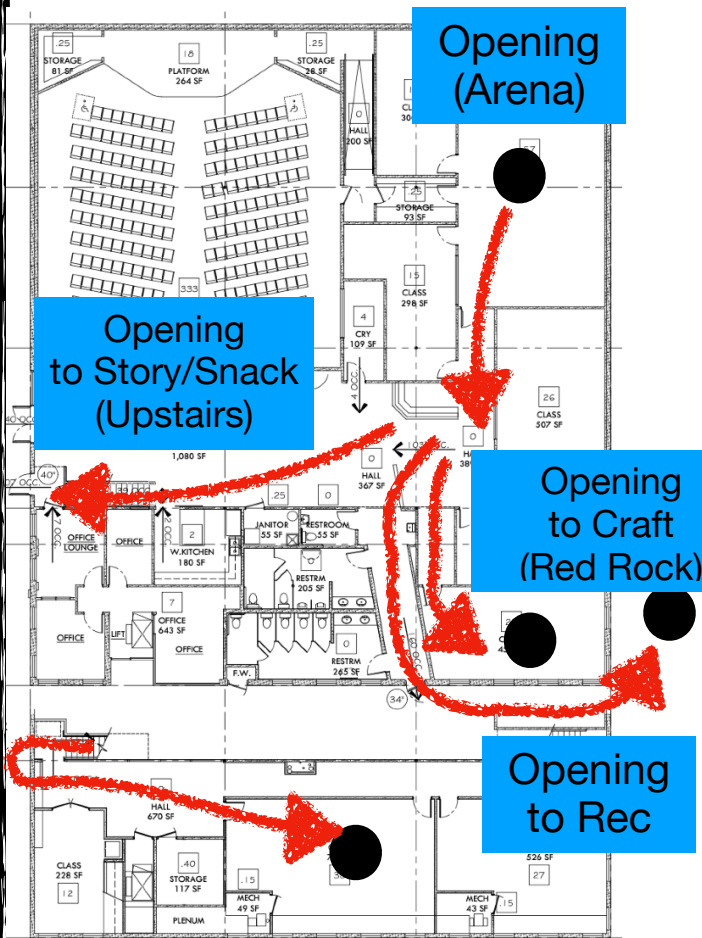
7+ Rotation Path
